September 15th

July 15th or later, depending on the visa process of your home country.

Requirements

- **No NC (Numerus Clausus) or minimum GPA required**
- **Individual selection process based on:**
 - **Online application**
 - **Motivation letter and CV**
 - **Interview with Admissions and Head of Study Program**
- **Certificate of Secondary Education**
For applicants from certain countries (e.g. USA, Canada, Mexico, Vietnam, Korea, Brazil, Argentina, Ecuador) it is mandatory to level out the gap between the different education systems with an International Foundation Year.
- **Proof of English Language Proficiency**
minimum of: C1 level (CEFR), or IELTS score of 6.5, or an internet-based TOEFL score of 100 points
