

I have no access to the full text of the article via the Electronic Journals Library as well as the databases from our library and other local libraries. How can I get the full text of the article anyway?

Items which cannot be found either in our University library or in other libraries in Karlsruhe can be acquired by interlibrary loan. Books and copies can be obtained through this method. The desired item must, however, be owned by a German library. You can borrow books online here: [Interlibrary Loan](#). Alternatively, you can send us your order in the Interlibrary loan request to [bibl\(at\)karlshochschule.de](mailto:bibl(at)karlshochschule.de). The fee for interlibrary loans is €1,50. A book's or article delivery usually takes two to four weeks. Once your order reaches us, we will let you know through an E-mail addressed to your Karlshochschule E-mail account. You can then pick up your ordered books and/or articles at our library desk. We will then make sure they are returned to their usual location. Regularly, you will be permitted to keep your loaned items for a period of four weeks, minus three days of return delivery. If you have need of a longer lending period, please contact us in time.
