What is about?

Karlshochschule International University is a state-recognized, non-profit private university in Karlsruhe. With an inter- and transdisciplinary approach, our focus is on economics and social sciences. Our students come from more than 60 different countries and learn from and with professors and lecturers from various disciplines and industries. As part of the community projects, students engage in a civic project - which may be about sustainability, diversity, justice, or a completely different topic. The topics are either developed by the students themselves - or suggested by an external partner.

How does it work?

The basis for the community project is a project outline: What is the goal of the project, how can the students contribute to achieve this goal?

If possible, the project should be feasible in active exchange with your organization.

You define in advance how many students are suitable for your project - we suggest team sizes of four to eight students.

The project runs from the beginning of October to December or from March to June - in January/ June there is a final event with a presentation of the results, to which representatives of your organization are welcome!
